About the course

Married Love is a course that provides couples with practical knowledge and skills for living an enriched married life, which has a positive impact on their family life.

The course is designed for both husband and wife to attend together and participate in each session. Developed by professionals at IFFD (International Federation for Family Development, www.iffd.org), the course uses the Harvard case study method to explore issues facing couples and their families. It is meant to give confidence and practical assistance to couples, helping them to continue growing in love for each other, and with this renewed love, to go forward in enriching their daily family life.

In a friendly atmosphere, participating couples acquire skills from this program that enable them to deal with situations that come up in their own married life. It also provides them with the means to improve as persons, spouses and parents, to increase the quality of their married love and family life.
