

Memorandum to people who attend activities of Association for Educational Projects Ltd (AEPL) in relation to the outbreak of Coronavirus

15 March 2020

I am writing with an update regarding the outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19).

Our priority is the wellbeing of everyone involved in activities organised by AEPL's educational projects.

As you know, health protocols regarding COVID-19 are being regularly updated by the Australian and NSW Government.

- In the event that you present with flu-like symptoms, we ask that you leave the activity as soon as possible.
- If you meet any of the criteria for self-isolation, please notify the Director of the Study Centre you would normally attend and refrain from attending the Centre until you have been cleared.
- Community service activities, such as visits to nursing homes, have been cancelled until further notice.

AEPL organises activities for both adults and children, and it is understood that in the case of children responsibility for these matters lies with their parents.
